Services Held for Mrs. Wright Today

Last rites were said today for Mrs. Clara Wright, 74, an Oakland resident for more than 30 years and daughter of the late Dr. Henry N. Bolander, former State superintendent of public instructions and later superintendent of schools in San Francisco.

Mrs. Wright died last Tuesday at her home, 1814 11th Street. Services were conducted today at the Grant D. Miller chapel on East Fourteenth Street by Rev. W. H. G. Batterskill, pastor of St. James Episcopal Church, followed by cremation.
