Dear Mrs. Musser:

It is with regret that I write you confirming the telegram of recent date which informed you of the death of your husband, Captain Samuel S. Musser, 0900097, Air Corps, on 26 November 1944 in Aden, Arabia.

The official casualty report states that he was killed in an airplane crash, on which he was a passenger.

I wish there were additional information to give you but unfortunately details of the circumstances surrounding airplane accidents are seldom included in the original report to the War Department. However, you may feel sure that if further particulars are received they will be transmitted to you at once.

I realize that there is little which may be said or done at this time to lessen your sorrow but it is my hope that in time you may find sustaining comfort in the knowledge that he died while serving his country.
