I John Goatman of the Parish of Chaceley in the County of Worcester Governour being sick and weak in body but of sound and disposing mind memory and understanding, do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say)

First I give and bequeath unto my Nephew Charles Goatman the Sum of Five Pounds and my best hat.

I give and bequeath to my Nephew John Goatman the Sum of One Guinea.

I give and Devise unto John Seal of the parish of Chaceley aforesaid Yeoman and to my brother Samuel Goatman of Tuckesbury in the County of Gloucester Yeoman. All that Messuages or Tenement Garden Household goods and Implements of Household and Land containing by estimation half an Acre four Perch and an half be the same more or less situate standing lying and being in the Parish of Chaceley aforesaid To hold the same unto the said John Seal and Samuel Goatman their Heirs and Assigns Upon Trust and confidence, notwithstanding that when necessity requires, or as soon as they can after my Decease that the said John Seal and Samuel Goatman shall vend sell and dispose off all the said Messuages or Tenement Garden Household goods Land Hereditaments and premises (Except the good on which I live) to the best benefit and advantage and for the most Money they may or can and out of the monies arising by the sale of the said Messuages or Tenement Garden Household goods Land and premises by me before devised they the said John Seal and Samuel Goatman shall well and truly pay the above mentioned Legacies that are hereinbefore bequeathed by me and the Monies that shall be then remaining shall be paid by the said John Seal and Samuel Goatman unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth Goatman in manner hereafter mentioned.

(That is to say) the Sum of Two Shillings per Week weekly and every week until the Sum of Money so remaining as aforesaid shall be expended. And my will and desire is that if my said Wife Elizabeth Goatman shall happen to

executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former or other
Will or Wills by me at any time heretofore made and declare this and this
only to be my last Will and Testament.

Seal this twenty seventh day of July in the Year of our Lord One thousand
