

Margaret Williams Walters

Margaret was the daughter of Edward Williams and Jane Richards (*Williams*). Born on 26 December 1835 in Llanelly, Carmarthenshire, South Wales, Margaret lived to marry William Leigh Walters in Sion Chapel, Llanelly and to be the mother of nine children as follows:

Margaret Ann Williams Walters	Born: Married: Died: Buried:	Wellsville, Utah, 6 August 1868 No 31 August 1904 Wellsville, Utah
Edmund Williams Walters	Born: Married: Died: Buried:	Wellsville, Utah, 8 October 1870 Margaret Archibald 29 April 1926 at Ogden, Utah Wellsville, Utah

She was baptized in 1847 (*apparently in Wales*) by William Williams and immigrated to Utah along with her husband William Leigh Walters and their children born to them at that time. Margaret died 24 October 1870 and was buried in the southwest corner of the Wellsville cemetery in Utah.
