Mrs. ALICE FRIES, wife of Albert J. Fries of Claysburg, died at her home at 2:45 o'clock yesterday afternoon, after an extended illness. She was born in Claysburg on Apr. 22, 1856 the daughter of PAUL and ANNA (STIFFLER) MAUK, and spent her entire life there. Surviving are her husband, 8 sons and daughters, JOHN W. FRIES and Mrs. CARRIE F. IRVIN, both of Claysburg, EDGAR H. of Duncansville, JACOB M. of Altoona, Miss MARY FRIES, a teacher in the Altoona schools. FRANK P. of Pittsburgh, ELIZABETH G. of New York City and RALPH A. FRIES of Alberta, Canada and 2 sisters-in-law Miss MARTHA FRIES and Mrs. Henrietta MAUK, both of Claysburg and 1 brother-in-law AMOS B. NOLAN, of Altoona.
