

Arthur Holybee Passes Away At *Jan* Boise, Idaho *3-4-1959*

Funeral services for Arthur L. Holybee were held Feb. 2, at the McBratney-Alden Chapel in Boise, Idaho. Mr. Holybee passed away at St. Luke's Hospital after a short illness. He had been a resident of Boise for 32 years.

Arthur Holybee was born in Georgetown, Texas, a son of Charles F. and Mary S. Holybee, and spent his early years in Texas, Oklahoma and New Mexico. He came to Paonia in 1899. In August, 1906, he was married to Iva Rookstool of Hotchkiss and six children were born to the couple: Roy A. Holybee of Las Vegas, Nev., James O. Holybee of Baker, Ore., Mrs. Gladys Fiquay and Mrs. Hazel Barry, both of Mountain Home, Ida., Mrs. Arlene Tefft of Paonia, and another daughter, Elsie Ruth Couchman who preceded him in death. Another son by a former marriage, Eugene Holybee of Portland, Ore., also survives. Mrs. Holybee passed away in 1919.
