

CHARLES E. SEAMAN

Charles E. Seaman, a life long resident of Greenport, who was a retired engineer on the Long Island Railroad, passed away at the Central Suffolk Hospital, Riverhead, on Saturday, December 18, 1965. Mr. Seaman, who was 88 years of age, was a son of the late Charles and Susan Tuthill Seaman. He retired about sixteen years ago after being employed as an engineer on the Long Island Railroad for thirty years.
