Lillie May Oakey Regan, 85, of 1 Creighton, died Thursday at her home following an illness.

She was born Dec. 9, 1888 at Bennington, Idaho, the daughter of L. Heber and Amelia Farley Oakey Foden and was reared at Montpelier.
