MRS. HAALK, 57, ANSWERS CALL

Rock Island Resident 40 Years,
D Succumbs Following Two
Operations.

Mrs. Dorothea Haalk, aged 57 years, a resident of Rock Island 40 years, passed away at 8:45 o'clock last night in the Moline City hospital. Mrs. Haalk was removed to the hospital two weeks ago and submitted to two operations. She had resided with her daughter, Mrs. Della Steinhilber, 2015 Twenty-seventh street.

Mrs. Haalk, who was formerly Miss Dorothea Ohms, was born May 2, 1864, in Germany and came to this country, directly to Rock Island, in 1882. She was married to John Haalk, 39 years ago. He preceded her in death three years. She was a member of the ladies' aid society of the Evangelical Church of Peace, the German Sisters, and was also a member of May Flower camp, No. 101, Royal Neighbors.

Surviving are a son, William Haalk, two daughters, Mrs. Theresa Utermohl and Mrs. Della Steinhilber; a brother, Charles Ohms, and two sisters, Mrs. John Timm, all residing in Rock Island. Engeland and Mrs. Elizabeth Three grandchildren also survive.
