# Rock Island Man Succumbs at 78; Rites Saturday

Adolph A. Steinhilber, 78, of 2015 27th St., Rock Island, died at 2:20 this morning in St. Anthony's Hospital, following an extended illness.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 Saturday afternoon in the Wheelan Funeral Home. The Rev. C. H. Rohlfing, pastor of the Church of Peace, and the Rev. F. J. Rolf, pastor emeritus of the church, will officiate. Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery, Rock Island.

Friends may call after noon tomorrow at the funeral home.

Mr. Steinhilber was born Aug. 12, 1880, in Germany, a son of Mr. and Mrs. Julius Steinhilber. He moved to Oshkosh, Wis., in 1881, and to Rock Island in 1896.

He married Adele Haalk Aug. 4, 1902, in Rock Island.

Mr. Steinhilber was employed for 36 years at the Servus Rubber Co., Rock Island. He was master mechanic of the organization at the time of his retirement in 1954. He was a member of the Church of Peace.

Surviving are the widow; two sons, Leo J. and Harold W., both of Rock Island; three grandchildren; a brother, Paul, of Davenport, and two sisters, Mrs. Hulda Fuhs and Mrs. Clara Ruddy, both of Portland, Ore.

His parents, a daughter, a brother and a sister preceded him in death.
