

OBITUARY.

Died at Willard City, Box Elder County, May 21, 1871, DWIGHT HARDING, aged 61 years and 24 days. He was the son of Ralph and Azubal Harding, born in Southbridge, Worcester County, Massachusetts, April 27, 1807. He was baptized in North Weatherfield, Genesee County, State of New York, February, 1833, by Elder Leonard C. Rich. Was married to Phebe Holbrook in the same month, and emigrated to Clay County, Missouri, in July, 1835, and removed to Caldwell, 1836. Was driven with the Saints from Missouri, 1839, to Quincy, Ill. Stayed at Quincy one year, and removed to Nauvoo in 1840. Left with the Saints in the Spring of 1846, wintered at the camp of the Saints at Puncal in '46-'47, and removed to Winter Quarters in the Spring of '47. He emigrated to the Valley in September, 1850, and settled at Willow Creek. He ever maintained a fervent desire, and was faithful to his profession for the kingdom of God. He filled many important offices in the church, and was President of the High Priests in Willard at his decease.—Com.
