

A photograph of Corintha Ellen and her family, all grown and gathered together for the first time in many years, has been found, and it is here set forth, with details of the persons present, as follows:

The above picture was taken 22 Sept. 1969, Corintha Ellen's birthday, when she was 87, and it was the first time all the children had been together in 40 years. ADA ALICE OLMSTEAD

The third child of Daniel Philip Olmstead and Mary Jane Cooper, was Ada Alice, born 30 November 1885 at Woodland, called "Camas" in Summit County, Utah.

No separate picture of Ada Alice as a child has been found. In the picture in the foregoing section, she is the child standing between her parents.

In the 1917 family group picture in the foregoing section, she stands beside her then husband Willard (called "Wid" Palmer) and the boy Newel Squire Crowley, and immediately behind Clarence Edmund Crowley, Sr.

In the photograph of the daughters of Daniel Philip and Mary Jane, which is in the foregoing section, she is the first lady at the left in the back row, standing immediately behind her sister Ardell Olmstead.

A portrait of Ada Alice with her husband Wid Palmer, exists, and is believed to be in the possession of Lola Dawn Hernandez, of Blackfoot, Idaho, a daughter of Ardell Olmstead and Malan Robinson. A copy taken from that portrait many years ago is here set forth, although dim and inadequate, being the best at hand.



No photograph of Philip's father Roland LeRoy Robbins has been found, nor any photograph of Ada's subsequent husbands (2) Alva Probes or (3) Harry Marriott. Her fourth and final marriage was to Willard James Palmer.

The circumstances which brought about Ada's numerous marriages are not known, but probably could be traced in court records. No particular reason for such a search has been seen, since there was no issue by any marriage except the first.

Ada Alice died 10 November 1935.

A note appears in the family archives that two of the sons of Mary Elizabeth Olmstead Crowley and Clarence Edmund Crowley, Byron Crowley and his brother Oliver Ralph Crowley, served as pallbearers at the funeral of Ada Olmstead Palmer.

A little other statistical data also appears:

Ada divorced Roland LeRoy Robbins 19 December 1910, and contrary to the foregoing statement that she married him 8 December 1906, one family record shows the marriage as 7 December 1905.
