

EVA OLMSTEAD

Fifth child of Daniel Philip Olmstead II and Mary Jane Cooper, this quiet, unassuming lady, mother of a large family, was born 26 October 1892 at Gilestown, in Emery County, Utah.

She married Samuel Carlos Lowder 3 March 1915, at Thomas, in Blackfoot vicinity, Bingham County, Idaho, the ceremony being performed by LDS Bishop John R. Williams, as shown in Bingham County Marriage Record Vol. 3 p. 2. Thereafter she lived most of her life at Rupert, in Minidoka County, where she died 5 May 1965, and is buried. Her husband Samuel Carlos Lowder was born in Star Valley, Wyoming 6 November 1892, and was buried in the Rupert LDS Cemetery 2 Feb. 1965.

It is curious that Eva and Carlos were born only about a month apart, and died in the same year, 1965, a few months apart.

Eva was known as "Eve" and was almost never called by her full name Eva. She appears in the foregoing picture, in the item about her brother Daniel, standing beside him. In the following, she appears standing behind her Mother and by the side of her sister Corintha Ellen. Numerous photographs of "Aunt Eve" are held by members of her family. The one here set forth is an excellent one:
