# Mrs. Erbst, 82, Once Resident, Taken by Death

Mrs. Dorothy L. Erbst, 82, died at 3:05 yesterday afternoon at her home, four miles west of Andalusia, where she resided with a grandson, Raymond E. Erbst.

Funeral services will be held at 2:30 Monday afternoon, at the Knox-Larson Funeral Home, with the Rev. Fred J. Rolf of Rock Island officiating. Burial will be in Chippiannock Cemetery.

Friends may call after noon Sunday.

Mrs. Erbst, the former Dorothy Timm, was born March 28, 1880, in Germany, a daughter of Heiwick and Elise Timm. She moved as an infant with her parents from Germany to Rock Island, where she attended schools.

She was married to Emil F. Erbst Oct. 20, 1900, in Rock Island.

She resided in Rock Island until 1931, when she moved to a farm near Davenport. Following her husband's death in 1947, she returned to Rock Island. She had resided near Andalusia for the past two years.

She was a member of the Church of Peace, Rock Island.

Surviving are a son, Raymond W., of Rock Island; five grandchildren; 12 great-grandchildren; and a sister, Mrs. Elizabeth Person of Detroit, Mich.

In addition to her husband, a sister and two brothers preceded her in death.
