

DANIEL PHILIP OLMSTEAD III

Daniel Philip Olmstead III was born 3 April 1890 at Woodland (Camas) in Summit County, Utah.

He married Borghild Lydia Olsen 8 January 1918, was divorced from her, many years later, and they had one daughter Wanda, a public official in Utah for many years, who died in Salt Lake City, Utah.

Daniel Philip III graduated from New York City Academy of Music as their #246294. He is well remembered for his delight in playing the banjo and the guitar and singing western songs to his own accompaniment. He was skilled, but never took advantage of his training professionally, and lived and died a humble sort of man. He died 19 March 1963 at Blackfoot, Idaho, and is there buried.

Photographically, he is little known, being a retiring sort of chap, but some pictures do exist. The following is the best. He is the tall neatly dressed man in the center of the back row between his brother Cyrus and his sister Eva.
