# Edward Timm, 69, Of Rock Island Taken by Death

Edward Timm, 69, Rock Island, died at 3 a.m. today in the home of his son and daughter-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. LeRoy H. Timm, rural route 1, Milan, where he had been residing for the last two weeks.

Funeral services will be held Monday morning at 8:30 o'clock in the Wheelan funeral home and at 9 o'clock in St. Ambrose Catholic church, Milan. The Rev. John Callahan, pastor, will officiate. Burial will be in Calvary cemetery.

Friends may call at the funeral home after 4 p.m. Saturday. The rosary will be recited there at 8 p.m. Sunday.

Mr. Timm was employed as a store clerk at the East Moline State hospital for seven years until illness forced him to retire about two months ago. Prior to that he was employed at the Farm-all works of the International-Harvester company, Rock Island. He was born Feb. 28, 1884, in Rock Island, a son of Heiwich and Elise Timm. He was reared and received his education and resided practically all his life in Rock Island. He married Anna Meyer, Nov. 8, 1905, in Rock Island.

Surviving are his mother, Mrs. Elise Timm, Rock Island; the son, LeRoy; two daughters, Mrs. Fred Burkhead and Mrs. Wallace Schroeder, both of Rock Island, and three sisters, Mrs. Dora Erps and Mrs. Lily Patsch, both of Rock Island, and Mrs. Elizabeth Pierson, Detroit, Mich.

He was preceded in death by his father, wife and two sons.
