Oliver Haroldsen, 98, of Idaho Falls, died Sept. 25, 1991, at Good Samaritan Nursing Center.

He was born May 4, 1893, at Hyrum, Utah, to Christian and Annie Holm Haroldsen. He moved to Idaho Falls in 1905 and settled at Willow Creek near Idaho Falls. He at-



Haroldsen attended Hyrum and Jernigan schools. He also attended Ricks Academy.

On Jan. 2, 1923, he married Celesta Ottley in the Salt Lake City LDS Temple. He farmed and ranched in the St. Leon area for many years. His wife died July 29, 1990.

He was an active member of the LDS Church. He served a mission to the Northeastern states from 1916 to 1919, and to California from 1929 to 1930. He served in the bishopric, as Sunday school superintendent and as an Idaho Falls LDS Temple officiator. He was a member of the board of directors for Progressive Irrigation District. He enjoyed singing in the choir.

Survivors include his sons, Grant O. Haroldsen, Fred O. Haroldsen, and Ray O. Haroldsen, all of Idaho Falls, and Orvil O. Haroldsen of Sima, Calif.; a sister, Alice Anderson of Orem, Utah; 19 grandchildren; and 58 great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by seven brothers and sisters and two great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be Monday at 11 a.m. at the Coltman LDS 3rd Ward, 6925 N. 15th East on St. Leon Road, with Bishop Douglas A. Knapp officiating. Visitation will be Sunday from 7 to 9 p.m. at Wood Funeral Home in Idaho Falls and again Monday for one hour before services at the church. Burial will be in Fielding Memorial Park.
