

# Salt Lake Soldier Killed in Action

Cpl. William M. Layton, 23, was killed in action in Korea March 13 while serving in the "Heart-break Ridge" area, according to word received by his parents from the Department of Defense.

An infantryman, he was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Lynn C. Layton, 2034 Laird Dr. He was a member of the 23rd Infantry Regiment.

A business student of the University of Utah prior to his entry into the Army in December, 1950, he had been a member of the Lambda Delta Sigma fraternity.

Cpl. Layton served a Spanish-American mission for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

Surviving are his parents and two brothers, Robert Lynn and Richard Gary Layton, all of Salt Lake City.
