Born August 31, 1918 at Bismarck North Dakota to Walter Lee Caddell and Bridget Marie Fogarty Caddell. When about four years old she moved with her family to Iron Mountain Michigan living there until she was about eight years old. The family then moved to Rapid City South Dakota where she graduated from high school in 1937.

On October 27, 1937 she and Wm Jewel Byrd were married. They moved to Butte Montana where they lived until 1944. Two sons were born to this union. They were divorced Friday October 13, 1944.

Frances then moved to Idaho where she went to telegrapher school at Pocatello Idaho. After graduation she worked for the Union Pacific Railroad. In the fall of 1948 she was sent to Pingree Idaho to work as agent-telegrapher for the Union Pacific RR. Here she met and married Reed J Brown. He was working for the T S Vanderford as warehouse foreman. He later became Rural letter carrier for the postal service working out of Pingree. At the time of his death August 15, 1979 he was still carrying the mail. Frances continued living on the family farm until May of 1997 when she moved to Blackfoot Idaho for six months. December 1997 she moved to Tracy California.

She was a member of the LDS Church serving a Family History Mission to Salt Lake City, Utah in 1988.

She was preceded in death by her parents, one brother, Michael Burke Caddell. She is survived by three sons, Stanley R, Jackie, Byrd, Seattle WA, Jerry L, Karen, Byrd, Salt Lake City Utah, Rex A, Linda, Brown, Tracy CA. Eighteen grandchildren and thirty great grandchildren.
