1840:

Deed: B. M. Hall to T. Jeff Johnson, 40 acres, 17 March 1845.

Know all men by these presents that Bartlett M. Hall of the county of Nacogdoches & Republic of Texas on this day Bargained and sold and do bargain and sell to T. Jeff Johnson of the aforesaid county & Republic a certain lot or parcel of land laid off of my headright land adjoining the Melrose tract known as my old residence place designated and bounded as follows, beginning at the North West corner of the Melrose tract near the old San Antonio road running near north with my father's line [John Hall] & mine to a stake established by Luncy & Lively thence east to Skillern's line to a stake & stake witnessed (?) by two red oaks one bearing rather north & the other south ___ James Skillern's line to the old Antonio Road to Skillern's corner thence ... to the beginning embracing forty acres more or less the receipt of the purchase money is hereby acknowledged ... I bind myself, ... to defend ... against all claims whatsoever (except that of Bud Martin) to T Jeff Johnson... this [17 Mar 1845]
