I do give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Margaret as much of my household stuff and kitchen furniture as she may choose and also one milch cow and three sheep allowing her the choice amongst those of which I shall die possessed. and it is my will and do hereby order

Three daughters Elizabeth, Margaret, and Mary (Mary is youngest).

the sum of <sup>four hundred</sup> pounds the first part thereof unto my youngest daughter Mary, and the sum of one hundred pounds, the last part or residue thereof unto my three daughters Elizabeth Margaret and Mary equally to be divided between them, and further my said son Jacob his heirs or assigns paying for and out of his moiety or part of the lands and premises aforesaid unto my said three daughters Elizabeth Margaret and Mary equally to be divided between them, the sum of three hundred pounds in specie of gold or silver coins.

Oldest daughter was Elizabeth.

Sons: oldest was Michael then John, George and Jacob.

Wife: Margaret. Children in this order: Michael, Elizabeth (wife of Henry Gerber), John, Margaret (wife of Martin Bare), George, Mary (or Maria/Polly wife of Henry Snider), and Jacob.
