### **Assembly Candidate Not Worried For He's Going to Navy**

The strange case of a candidate who doesn't care whether or not he is elected on November 2 came to light today, with the announcement that **Walter S. Baring**, one of the Washoe county Democratic assembly nominees for the assembly, is entering the navy in the next few days.

Under the Nevada statutes, a candidate for an office cannot withdraw after being named a nominee in the primaries. If Baring is elected, despite his announcement that he is joining the armed forces, he will resign his office as an assemblyman and the vacancy will be filled by the county commissioners. He will enter the navy as a radio technician and expects his call to active service some time this week.

Baring represented Washoe county in the assembly in 1937 and later was a senate attache in Washington and during this time was in charge of the page boys' school. Since returning to Reno, he has been in the furniture business.
