So it looks like Michael Bard and first wife, Magdalena Bear, married about 1781, had 7 daughters plus George who only lived a short time b. 23 Oct 1791 to 20 Jan 1793 and Emanuel b. 5 May 1793, who married Maria R.

Then Michael Bard and 2nd wife Catherine Weiss, married 26 Apr 1808, had the following children: George Bard b. 1809 d. 1873, Hannah Bard b. ~1811 d. 1889, Jacob Bard b. ~1815 d. 1884, Benjamin Bard b. ~1818 d. 1877, Veronica Bard b. ~1819, Judith Bard b. ~1821. All of these children and wife are mentioned in father Michael's will.
