### EMMETT L. HOWELL.

Emmett L. Howell, aged sixty-five years, a well-known architect, a resident of Horseheads, died in this city Wednesday night of blood poisoning. A few weeks ago, Mr. Howell ran a wooden sliver under a finger nail, from which blood poisoning developed and spread through his system. The deceased is survived by his widow, a daughter, Mrs. W. G. Fudge, of Elmira, and a brother, Harry Howell, of Sullivanville. The funeral was held Friday at 3 p. m., at the residence of Sylvester Botsford, on Franklin street, in Horseheads. The Rev. R. D. Stanley officiated and burial was in Maple Grove cemetery.
