

Henry Muller dies at 87; service Thursday

Henry Muller, 87, American Falls, passed away at Power County Hospital December 5th following a short illness.

He was born July 16, 1890 in Findorf, Germany, a son of Mr. and Mrs. William Muller.

He and his father moved to the United States in 1908 when he was 18 years old, settling in Helix, Oregon, where they farmed, later moving to American Falls. He purchased the Frank Roberts farm and later the Fay Brown Farm.

He was a charter member of the Lutheran Church. He enjoyed the outdoors and fishing.
