**WEAVER TOMBSTONES DISCOVERED**

ON A HILL BESIDE A VERY OLD APPLE TREE

APPROXIMATELY 200 YARDS SOUTH OF THE RED BARN

AT

3625 STORMS CREEK ROAD, TERRE HAUTE, OH

On 28 February 2000, Bob and Flossie Hulsizer found them buried and replaced them in an upright position. They are:

“In Memory of  
Mary, Consort of  
Christopher Weaver  
Departed this life May  
1808 in the 44<sup>th</sup> year of  
her age.

“In Memory of  
Christopher Weaver  
departed this life Sept 13  
1835 in the 7???  
of his age.

(Top is broken from the epitaph below)

and a charming neighbor. Her  
amiable deportment & christi  
an virtues (divined?) her to all.”

“Integrity in all his deal----- and  
in all his sayings Piety to---- GO--  
and kindness towards a -----ade

(We found buried what could be part of a  
footstone, but with no inscription.)

(We found a buried footstone with the  
inscription “C. W.”)
