IN THE NAME OF THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN,

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, Samuel Tracy of the County of Livingston Michigan on the 24th day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty four purchased from the State of Michigan, the Lands hereafter described, pursuant to the Laws of said State, then in force and in such cases made and provided: And Whereas, the said Samuel Tracy has paid for said Lands pursuant to the conditions of said sale, and the Laws of the State, duly enacted in relation thereto, the sum of 1000 Dollars and 00 Cents, and all legal interest thereon accrued, as fully appears by the Certificate of the proper officers, now on file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Michigan, being Certificate No. 1849 for Section 24 of Range 10 and Town 3

Now, Therefore, I, Andrew P. Barlow Governor of said State, in consideration of the premises, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Laws of the said State, in such cases made and provided, DO ISSUE THIS PATENT, In the Name and by the Authority of the People of the State of Michigan, hereby granting and conferring unto the said Samuel Tracy and to his heirs and assigns forever, the following piece or parcel of LAND, situate in the State aforesaid, to wit: Section 24 of Range 10 and Town 3 of Livingston County Michigan.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described and granted premises unto the said Samuel Tracy and to his heirs and assigns, to his and their sole and only proper use, benefit and behoof forever, as provided by the Laws of said State, against the lawful claims or claims of all persons whatsoever.

In Testimony Whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of the State to be hereunto affixed.
