

# General Ser Held Monday Miss Janie Dunham

Miss Janie Dunham, a former prominent resident of Slidell, and sister of Mr. B. P. Dunham, passed away at the Touro Shakespeare Home in Algiers, La., Sunday at 2:00 o'clock.

Miss Dunham had been in ill health for the past ten years and suffered a stroke shortly before her demise. She was 69 years of age.

Miss Dunham had lived the greater part of her life in Slidell and New Orleans and had many friends in the surrounding territory. She was superintendent of the hospital in Fort Worth, Texas, for some time, after she had graduated from the Touro Nursing School in 1899. For the past few years she had resided in New Orleans.
