Former Resident of Bethel Dies Friday--Mrs. Anniebelle Case Young, 69 years of age, a former resident of Bethel and vicinity, who died Friday morning in Shelbina, was laid to rest Sunday, December 8, the birthday of all three of her children, the children all having been born on December 8.

Mrs. Young, the wife of Ed Young, was born 27 April 1860 in Marion County and had lived in Shelby county for over 15 years. For almost a year they had made their home in Shelbina. She was married on 6 Decmeber 1881.

Besides her husband she is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Mary Enochs of Columbia; two sons, E. C. of Bethel and A. E. Young of Shelbina; two sisters, Mrs. Pearl West of Ewing and Mrs. Ella Cunningham of Perry, Ind. and four brothers, W. L. and Ernest Case of Lewistown and J. E. and J. L. Case of Quincy, Mrs. Young was a member of the Methodist Church.
