Monroe County, Alabama

11 December 1835; Deed Book A, p. 113/114: **Lewis Carnline** and wife **Lovisa Carnline** sell to Samuel Kelly for \$1000 the SW 1/4 of S 28, TSP 7N, R 7E, containing 160 and 30/100 acres of the land directed to be sold at Cahaba; and the SE 1/4 of S 28, TSP 7N, R 7E, containing 160 and 30/100 acres of the lands directed to be sold at Cahaba,... together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments, rights, members, privileges and appurtenance unto the above mentioned and described premises belonging or in any wise appertaining...Lovisa Carnline releases her dower to Samuel Kelly.

28 September 1837; Deed Book A, p. 461/462: **Lewis Carnline** and wife **Levica Carnline** sells to John Salter for \$250 the E 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of S 34, TSP 7, R 7, containing 80 acres more or less...Levica Carnline releases her dower to John Salter.
