I, C. D. Lehman, Superintendent of the State Public School, do hereby state that the commitment of Charles Frue to the State Public School under date of September 28, 1894 from the County Court of Milwaukee County, said court being a court of record, states that Charles Frue was three years of age on the 12th day of August, 1894, the father Charles Frue, the mother Emma Frue.

Further, the records of the State Public School show that on April 1, 1898 Charles Frue was indentured by the State Public School, by the authority of an act approved by the State Legislature April 9, 1885, into the home of George Becker of the Township of La Grange, Monroe County, Wisconsin. Although not legally adopted, as in many of these old cases Charles Frue took the name of Becker and has since that time been known as Charles G. Becker.
