It is during this third generation, that my information gets somewhat sketchy as far as Jacob III. I was able to obtain more informaton on his wife, Elizabeth, my grandmother and her family than him. I will be including this in my journey into the past and then into the present.

As his father before him, Jacob III was born in 1880 on the homestead originally purchased in 1856 in Rush Creek, Minnesota, in Hart County. He lived here and worked other farms until the year 1909 when he met and married Elizabeth Kilian. They purchased the 160 acre farm in Garvin Heights, Wilson, Minnesota, for \$14,000. This is the same farm Elizabeth was born on in 1885.

Jacob III was a very progressive farmer, using advanced methods and farming implements to produce maximum crop productions. It was this farm that throughout the years had two devastating fires that destroyed everything

that stood. In 1918, a tree fell on Jacob III and left him partially immobile. During this time when he was recuperating and clearing some brush, a spark from the fire he had going was blown into a hay stack. It caught fire and the fire burned all the buildings except for a small brick smokehouse. They proceeded to build again. They built a beautiful two-story stucco house which had all the latest conveniences, such as pressure running water, a bathroom, and a Delco Electric Plant which provided them their electricity. All the modern conveniences in those early days. It was not until 14 years later in 1932 that they experienced another devastating fire. Again, the stucco home was destroyed. This fire was caused from an explosion created from the combination of coal and oak wood which they used to provide heat. Again, they rebuilt and the house is standing to this day.

Jacob III and Elizabeth had 11 children born to them. The first six were born in the old brick house, and the next five were born in the new stucco home. They were farmers most of their lives and had acquired one of the best known farms in the area. Jacob III retired from the farm (year unknown) when they agreed to part company. Elizabeth moved to California where five of her children were living at the time, and Jacob III bought a 3-bedroom home and rented out two of the rooms for income. He died on October 28, 1965, at age 85 and is buried in St. Marys cemetery in Winona, Minnesota. Elizaeth passed away ten years later on December 22, 1975, at age 90. She is buried in Long Beach, California. There is a family picnic every year on Memorial Day commemorating her passing. On the following pages is the history of her family (Kilian) which began in 1805 in Hessen-Darstadt, Germany, with her great-grandparents and continues to the present.

### The Kilian Family

The saga begins in the year 1805 when Michael Kilian was born in Hessen-Darstadt. Nothing is known of his life prior to the marriage with Anna Maria Helfert of Oppenheim. She was born March 21, 1820. They had six children, three sons, and three daughters. Nicholas, who will become the next generation Kilian, was born on July 28, 1841. When he was 11 years old, he left Germany with his family to come to America. X

In the Spring of 1853, Michael with his family, bag and baggage, left the old familiar haunts and sailed for the United States. They settled in Onieda County in New York State, about 25 miles west of Utica on a 65-acre tract which his father purchased. On this farm, young Nicholas was reared to manhood and attended the district school for a short period and worked on the farm with his father. He lived with his parents for 13 years. In the Spring of 1866, interested in the West through communication with his brother, Adam, Nicholas heeded his desire for the adventure and pioneer life and started for Winona. Adam had a carriage works business in Winona. Nicholas went the entire distance by rail and arrived in the early Spring. He entered the employment of his brother. The large carriage works was located outside the post office.

On April 5, 1869, Nicholas married Anna Hammering of Winona. Anna was born on November 11, 1851, in St. Louis, Missouri. At a very early age, she went to Winona with her parents.

Just before they married, Nicholas and his brother-in-law had purchased a 240-acre tract of wild timber land just two miles from Wilson. They divided the land equally, each taking 120 acres and began clearing it. That was the first step toward making a rich and productive farm. The land had been owned previously by pioneers who worked it.

Following their marriage, Nicholas and Anna enjoyed a short honeymoon trip to their farm at Wilson in a little crude hut formerly used as a granary. They began a long and successful career as farmers. This land was thickly covered in places with timber which had to be removed before the soil could be used to produce ordinary farm crops. Nicholas set about this task at once and each year added to his tract of farm soil until the farm was ideal with just enough timber reserved to supply fuel.

While on this farm, Nicholas and his family had many very interesting experiences. There were years when 50 bushels of barley were threshed per acre and when only 20 cents, and sometimes less, could be received for it. It entailed endless handling, owing to the large amount of grain but frequently did not bring profitable returns. There were also times when good yields were produced, and the prices were sufficiently high to warrant the extra work. Nicholas and Anna remained on the farm for 40 consecutive years.

Nicholas and Anna were very religious, and they sang in the church choir. Nicholas was 5 foot 6 inches tall and firm. He drank very little but he enjoyed some wine and he loved to sing. Anna made their clothes, including their socks. The neighbors would come to the home where she taught religion to them.

NICHOLAS KILIAN, venerable Winona county farmer, who received fatal injuries in a runaway accident here yesterday.

Returning from church late yesterday afternoon, Nicholas Kilian, 73-year old pioneer of Winona County was fatally injured when he attempted to stop a runaway team at the corner of Broadway and Lafayette streets. He was knocked down by a blow in the face and sustained injuries from which he died at the Winona Memorial Hospital at 9:20 last night. The accident occurred at 5 o'clock.

TRIES TO HALT HORSES

Witnesses say Mr. Kilian was in the act of crossing the street when the team rounded the corner. Instead of making an attempt to reach a point of safety, it is declared he raised his hands in an effort to bring the team to a stop. The next instant, he was lying unconscious in the street after the horses had passed. Relatives are inclined to believe, however, that the aged man, whose hearing was defective, did not realize his predicament until too late and then, raising his hands, thought to ward off the danger.

Mr. Kilian was taken to the hospital in an automobile. The shock, it was realized, had been too severe, and at the outset, there was little hope for recovery. His face was badly bruised, probably when a portion of the rigging on the runaway horses struck him. The victim failed to recover consciousness.

BOYS FRIGHTENED TEAM

The fatal accident is traced to mischievous boys who frightened the team by throwing something at them. The horses, belonging to Edward Oertli, residing across the river, were standing near the corner of Broadway and Liberty Streets when they broke into a run. The team traveled a short distance west on Broadway before the wagon was torn from them as a result of contact with a tree. With only a portion of the harness and rigging, they continued, rounding the corner of Lafayette where the aged man was struck. North on Lafayette the team ran to Third Street, where one of them fell and they were caught.

The runaway created considerable excitement in the business district, although few were aware of the tragic accident on Broadway.

Brief History of the Children

- Magdalen: - married Allan D. O'Brien on June 3, 1940. He passed away with cancer of the lungs on February 24, 1951. She married Lawrence W. Griffin on August 17, 1957. He passed away after suffering a stroke and heart attack on October 18, 1969. She married Robert H. Elliott on March 8, 1975, and they are now living in Hemet, California. He <sup>SHE</sup> retired in March 1975 and had been an employee at American Wholesale Hardware in Long Beach for 25 years. She had one son, Robert O'Brien, who is now living in Santa Rosa, California.
- Genevieve: - married James P. Ronan from Lewiston, Minnesota, on October 2, 1937. In 1940, James became an employee of Remington Rand, and in 1944, he was transferred to Los Angeles, California. They lived in the San Fernando Valley for many years. James retired at 65 and died shortly thereafter with a coronary thrombosis at the Santa Anita Race Track. Genevieve received a Bachelor of Arts Degree from the Los Angeles State College and was initiated into Alpha Delta Kappa in 1962. She taught 25 years in Winona County, Minnesota and in Los Angeles, California. Genevieve, when she retired, received a letter of sincere appreciation for many years of service from Tom Bradley, Mayor of Los Angeles. She then moved to Leisure World in Laguna Beach and later to Oceanside, California. She died here in April 1982 as a result of lymphocytic leukemia. They had no children.
- Elizabeth: - moved to Long Beach with brother, Leonard, in February 1941. While working as a secretary for the California Shipbuilding Corporation, she met and later married Walter D. Truax, Jr., on February 16, 1943. Walter was reported lost at sea when his Standard Oil Tanker was torpedoed and sunk in the Indian Ocean, March 12, 1944. On July 7, 1951, Elizabeth married John R. Carroll, Jr., a bank manager for Security Pacific Bank. They adopted two daughters and had one son. After 30 years of teaching in Winona County, Minnesota, Bellflower, and Santa Maria, California schools, Elizabeth retired. John Sr. retired after being employed with Security Pacific Bank for 42 years. Currently, however, John is still employed part-time for Business Development with Security Pacific Bank. Elizabeth (Beth) is still tutoring in their home in Santa Maria, California.
- Leonard: - in 1941, he and his wife-to-be, Eleanor Fraser, from Winona, Minnesota, moved to Long Beach, California, from Minnesota where they were married October 18, at St. Anthony's Catholic Church. They had two sons and one daughter. Leonard retired from North American Rockwell in 1975 after 30 years in Management. He and his wife, Eleanor, now make their home in Crestline, California.

Marcellus: - married Mildred Meiner in Owatonna, Minnesota. They moved to California in 1945 where Marcellus became a Supervisor while employed by Rockwell International. Mildred died in 1983. They had three daughters, twins, Katherine, Patricia, and Jeannette. Jeannette was killed in an auto accident at 19 years of age. After Marcellus retired from Rockwell, he moved to Sedona, Arizona, and is now living in a retirement community in Sun City, West Arizona.

Mariette - Mrs. Kenneth Erding, Wykoff, Minnesota. Mariette and Ken have four children, three boys and one daughter. Kenneth retired as Postmaster in 1982, and they continue to make their home in Wykoff, Minnesota.

Jacob: - born October 18, 1919, graduated from Cotter High School in Winona in 1939. He joined the Army Air Corps in 1940 and attended Spartan School of Aeronautics at Tulsa, Oklahoma. He served five years in the Army Air Force during World War II as an airplane mechanic, flight engineer, and Line Chief in Africa, Bainbridge, Georgia, and the Pacific Theater. He married Viola Shearer from Texas in 1943. They had four children. When war in the Pacific ended, he went to work for American Airlines in December 1945 at Fort Worth, Texas, and in 1947, they moved to Tulsa, Oklahoma, where he continued to work for American Airlines for 25 more years. The eldest son, Rohny, joined the Navy after graduation from high school and also became an airplane mechanic. While stationed at the Naval Air Base in Jacksonville, Florida, he was killed on his motorcycle soon after his 21st birthday. A youth and scout lodge at Briarwood Park in Tulsa was donated and dedicated in his memory. In 1972, Jake terminated with American Airlines at age 52, and they moved to New Braunfels, Texas, near Canyon Lake on the Guadalupe River.

Delores: - She was born July 31, 1923, and died at the age of 1 year, 8 months, 24 days, on April 24, 1925. A dark complexioned, beautiful child, her death was the result of drowning in the farm water stock tank.

Milton: - married to Laverne Vermeulen on September 3, 1951. They had six children. Laverne was a registered nurse and died in October 1981 from leukemia. She is buried at All Souls' Cemetery in Long Beach, California, near Milton's mother's grave. Milton worked for 28 years at a metal processing plant in Torrance, California. The family makes their home in Carson, California, and Yucca Valley, California.

Laura: - married Carlo Mascolo on November 20, 1954. They have four children and live in the San Fernando Valley in California.
