

# E. N. Johnson Dies

Death Comes Suddenly to Professor of  
Mathematics in Butler College.

Walter Wilson received a message Tuesday that his brother-in-law, Prof. E. N. Johnson, had died at noon at his home in Indianapolis, Ind. He had not been in robust health for some months and had been doing light work in the class room.

For over thirty years Dr. Johnson had been professor of mathematics in Butler College at Indianapolis. He is remembered here as "Lige" Johnson, first as post office clerk, then as teacher in Campbell College and later as its president from 1897 to 1903.

He is survived by his wife, formerly Miss Mattie Wilson, and a son, Richard, aged 33. Prof. Johnson was about 69 years old.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Friday and burial will be in Indianapolis. Walter Wilson left last night for Indianapolis to be present at the funeral.
