# STUBBS NAMES DOTEN FOR THE NEW CHAIR

---

Former Principal of University  
High School Now Head of  
Entomology Department

---

## MORE ATTENTION WILL BE GIVEN THIS STUDY

---

### Professor Whose Position Was Assigned to H. H. Howe Receives Better Place

---

**P**ROFESSOR SAMUEL DOTEN, formerly principal of the University High School, has been appointed by President Stubbs of the Nevada University as head of the department of entomology. This will establish a new course in the college and it will be connected with the experiment station.

**H. H. Howe**, who was until recently head of the High School at Carson City, was engaged by President Stubbs to fill the vacancy in the local school on request of Doten, the latter asking to remain in charge of High School work in Reno unless **Howe** was procured to take his place.

Doten is in Tonopah examining the schools there, but it was stated at his home yesterday that he will return here in a few weeks and begin

preparations for the coming university term. According to the statement given out at his home, the department of entomology was once before established in the local university but it was allowed to lapse several years ago. Its re-establishment will be in connection with the experiment station.

It is asserted that Principal **Howe** of the Carson High School intended to take a school in Sparks when his deposition was announced from the school of the former place. When this became known to Doten the latter asked that he be allowed to take the school in this city. If **Howe** had not accepted, it is averred, Doten would not have become head of the new department at the university.

"Doten was always a member of the experiment station at the Nevada University," said President Stubbs yesterday. "He was formerly head of the department of entomology. Before the term opens this fall an addition will probably be made to the experimental station laboratory under suggestion of Professor Doten. The study of insects in Nevada will then become an important part of the work at the local experiment station. Some few changes will be made in the department directed by Doten."

When the new mining building is completed we intend to complete the reorganization of the experiment station. Its location will then be changed also—probably to the old mining building. With the \$15,000 from the Government appropriation and the \$7,000 from the State appropriation a great work will be accomplished in the branch of research and investigation.
