Deed Abstracts¹**

30 September 1808, p.26: Deed from Michael See to **Lewis Carnline** for 50 acres on waters of Saluda for the consideration of \$150.

19 August 1815, p.26: Deed from **Lewis Carnline** to John Leaphart for 100 acres on waters of Saluda for the consideration of \$50.

11 February 1812, p. 26: Deed from **Cristian Caroline** to **Lewis Carline** for 618 acres on Saluda River for the consideration of (blank).²

19 August 1815, p.26: Deed from **Lewis Carnline** to John Leaphart for 50 acres on waters of Saluda for the consideration of \$50.

19 September 1814, p. 32: Deed from Henry M. Rutledge and James S. Guignard to **Lewis Carnline** for 703 acres on waters of Saluda for the consideration of \$175.75. Proved and acknowledged 28 January 1815.

28 August 1815, p. 40: Deed from **John Carnline** to John Shultz and Absalom Hendrix for 100 acres on Big Hollow Creek for the consideration of \$60. Proved and acknowledged 6 September 1815.

26 August 1815, p. 40: Deed from **Lewis Carnline** to Martin Free for 60 acres on waters of Saluda for the consideration of \$50. Proved and acknowledged 6 September 1815.

1 November 1818, p. 100: Deed from **George Carnlin**³ to Michael Eragle for 67 acres (description omitted) for the consideration of \$300. Proved 17 November 1819. Recorded (date omitted).

15 October 1813, p. 100: Deed from **Lewis Carline** to **George Carline** for 67 acres (description omitted) for the consideration of \$50. Proved 12 October 1816. Recorded (date omitted).⁴
