

CHASE TRIMBLE CALLED BY DEATH

Monday morning, a brief telegram dispatch imparted the sad information to relatives and friends of this community, that Chas Trimble had succumb to death in the Eastern States Mission where he has been laboring for the past year and a half. The telegram revealed none of the details relevant of the cause of his death, and the only information which we have up to date is the following brief account from the Salt Lake press.

"MISSIONARY SUCCUMBS TO TUBERCULOSIS IN EAST"

"Elder Robison Chas Trimble of Leamngton, Utah died in Pittsburg, Pa., Monday morning from tuberculosis according to a telegram to the First President of the Church from Preast B. H. Roberts, of the Eastern States Mission, received this morning. Elder Trmbie had been in the mission field since January 25, 1922. He was born at Fillmore July 30th, 1889.

"The body will be brought to Utah for burial by Elder Glen L. Loveless, leaving Pittsburgh tonight and arriving in Salt Lake Thursday."

The many friends and relatives of Mr. Trimble, in this, the town of his birth, boyhood and youthful days, deeply grieve his lose. It is expected that a large attendance will pay its last respect to this young man at his funeral services, which will be held at the Fillmore Ward chapple, next Sunday at 1 o'clock.
