Will of Lewis Carnline, 7 November 1843<sup>1</sup>

The State of Alabama } Regular Ex. has Comt  
 Pike County } November Term A.D. 1843 -

personally appeared in open Court Abraham  
 Cantaline and John Carnline who being duly  
 sworn depose and say that Lewis Carnline  
 late of said County deceased during his last  
 sickness while in sound mind called upon and  
 requested them to bear witness and have Com-  
 mitted to writing his last will and testament  
 which was as follows. I Lewis Carnley -  
 do hereby give and bequeath unto my beloved wife  
 Vida Carnley the following property to her own  
 especial use interest and behoof for and during  
 her natural life over and above what law  
 may be allowed her by law as my widow  
 to wit: the west half of the north west 1/4 of  
 section 9 Township 9 Range 20 also the  
 west half of south west quarter of section 9 -  
 and same Township & Range -  
 do - 2<sup>nd</sup> Also my Negro woman (Martha and  
 her child Willis - also one wagon and one yoke  
 of Oxen - also one sorrel mare - which said  
 property is to be and remain with her the said  
 Vida for and during her natural life and  
 at her death to be equally divided amongst  
 the following heirs of their legal Representatives  
 to wit - Jacob Carnley - Abraham Carnley  
 Jeremiah Carnley - Mulley Capers - wife of  
 Gabriel Capers - John Carnley - Daniel Comby  
 William Carnley Joseph Carnley and -  
 Lewis Carnley -

3<sup>rd</sup> And I do further will that John Carnley  
 be and I do hereby authorize and request him  
 my son John Carnley to be my Executor on  
 this my last will and testament -
