This matter coming on for hearing this the 15th day of April, 1953, pursuant to an order of this court issued on the 19th day of March, 1953, and it appearing to the court that due notice of the settlement of the final account of E.W. Spannagel, Executor of the estate of Isaac Harmon, deceased, has been given as required in said order and according to law, the court proceeded to examine the final account of the said E.W. Spannagel, and vouchers produced by him, and further examining the said E.W. Spannagel, under oath, and it appearing to the court that the said E.W. Spannagel has well and truly accounted for every part of said estate, and that no profit has been made by him through any increase in said estate, and there being no objections, and the court being fully advised:

It is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court that the accounts of the said Executor be, and the same are hereby finally settled, allowed and adjusted by the court, according to the terms and tenor of the final account of the said Executor filed herein, and distribution of said estate, according to the petition and in accordance with the terms of the last will and

paid and satisfied, and it further appearing from the verified account of said Executor that all state, county, school and municipal taxes, legally levied upon the personal property of said estate have been fully paid, and it further appearing that there are no inheritance and transfer taxes due the State of Oklahoma, as appears from order exempting said estate from payment of estate and inheritance taxes on file herein, and that said estate has been fully administered as shown by the final account of the said E.W. Spannagel, Executor of said estate, duly audited and allowed by this court, pursuant to due notice given and served, reference being had thereto, and that said estate is ready for distribution.

It further appearing to the court that due notice of the application for final decree herein determining the heirs, devisees and legatees of said Isaac Harmon, deceased, and assigning the residue of said estate to the persons entitled thereto by law, and in accordance with the terms of the last will and testament of the said Isaac Harmon, deceased, has likewise been duly given and served pursuant to law, in such case made and not provided, and it further appearing to the court that the said deceased died testate, and that the residue of the estate consists of the following described real estate, to-wit:

Lots 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20,
Block 7, in the Town of Ringling, Jefferson
County, Oklahoma,

and the sum of \$8.78.

And it further appearing to the court that under and by virtue of the terms of the last will and testament of the said Isaac Harmon, deceased, the above described property was devised, in equal shares, to the surviving children of said de-

I, Isaac Harmon, of Ringling, Jefferson County, State of Oklahoma, being now in good health, strength of body and mind, but sensible of the uncertainty of life and desiring to make disposition of my property and affairs while in health and strength, do hereby make, publish and declare the following to be my last will and testament, hereby revoking and cancelling all other or former wills by me at any time made.

(1) I direct the payment of all of my just debts and funeral expenses.

(2) I give and devise to my children, being five sons and three daughters, their heirs or assigns named as follows.
