Judgement, Daniel Carnley aka Cantaline Against Mathias Snider, 14 May 1851<sup>1</sup>

The State of Alabama  
County of Pike

Special Court of Probate  
May the 14<sup>th</sup> 1851.

To the Sheriff of said County

Whereas Daniel Cantaline alias Daniel Carnley, is entitled to the sum of fifty eight & 2/10<sup>ths</sup> — as appears to us of record, being the amount of his distributive share, as Son and heir to Lewis Cantaline late of said County deceased, and as decreed upon final settlement of said Estate; And whereas the said Daniel Carnley lately on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of February A.D. 1847, did then and there recover judgments, in the Orphan Courts of said County, for the sum of fifty eight and 2/10<sup>ths</sup> Dollars, against one Mathias Snider Administrator of said Lewis Cantaline deceased; And whereas said Daniel Carnley, legatee as aforesaid hath complained to my said Court, that said judgments is still unsatisfied, and that he has never received his distributive portion of said Estate; And it now appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that execution has not issued within a year and a day;

Now therefore we therefore do command you that you summon the said Mathias Snider to be and appear at a regular term of the Probate Court to be holden on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday in July next, and shew cause if any he have, why said judgments should not be renewed, and execution issue thereon according to the Statute in such cases made & provided.
