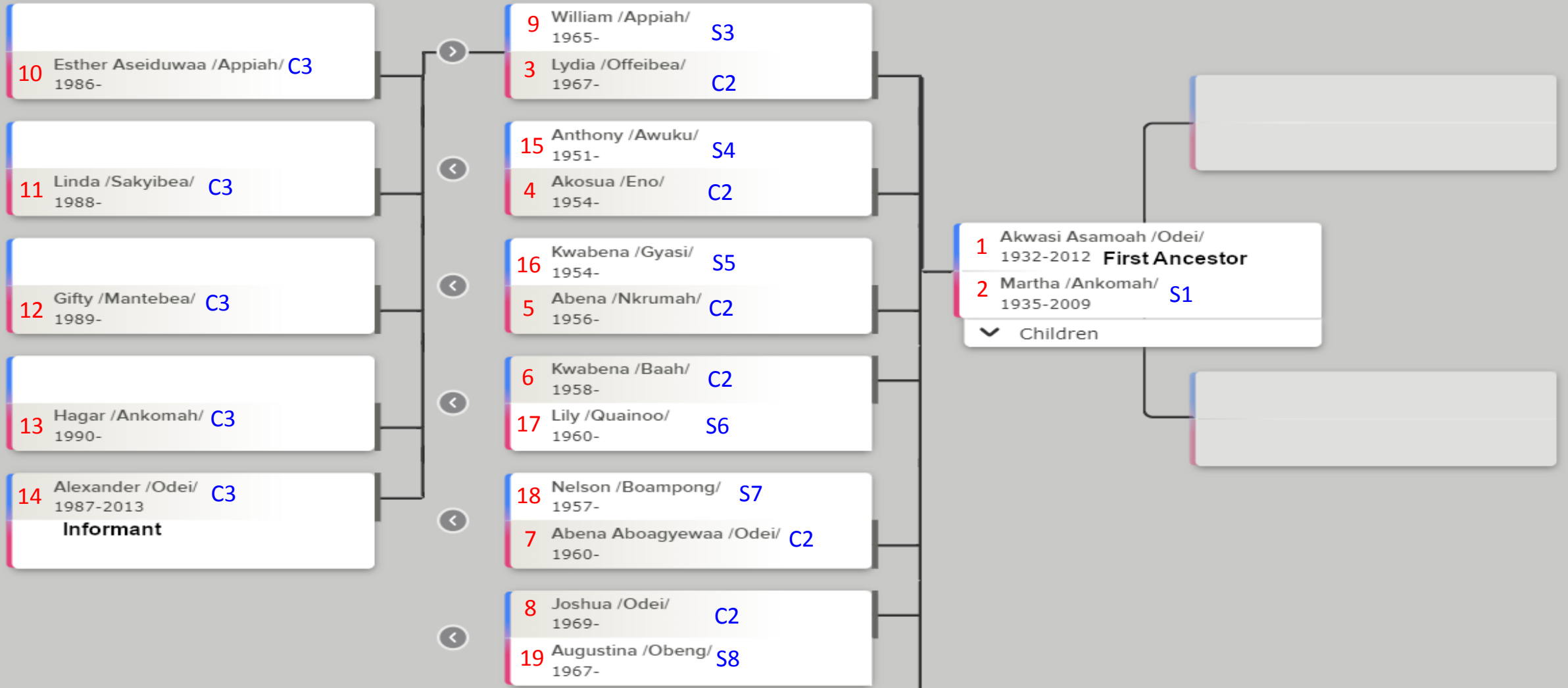

14	C3	M	Alexander Odei	Rules for Creating the Tree: 1. Starting with the First Ancestor, each name given by the informant is given a unique RIN #. Names should not be repeated. 2. Each person is given a relationship code (S or C) to explain their relationship to others in the tree. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Spouse = S of RIN #. So the person who is the spouse of the First Ancestor would be S1. b. C = C of Rin # of the mother. So each person who is a child of the wife of the First Ancestor would be C2.
