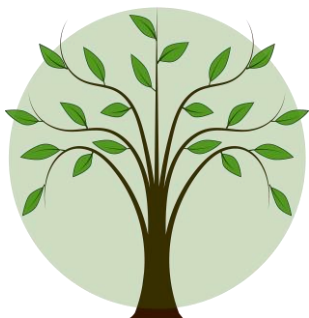

The center is run by volunteer staff and is subject to last minute closures. Please make an appointment to ensure someone is available to assist you:

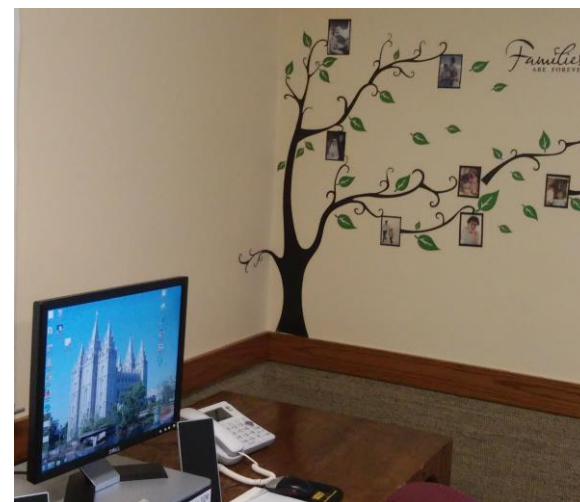
